He also spoke on audit insurance; 50% investment allowance; superannuation payments must be received into an employee's superannuation fund by the 30<sup>th</sup> June each financial year to be eligible for Government \$/\$ top-ups; write off bad debts before 30<sup>th</sup> June or you will be liable for gst/taxes; review assets depreciated to non-value.
